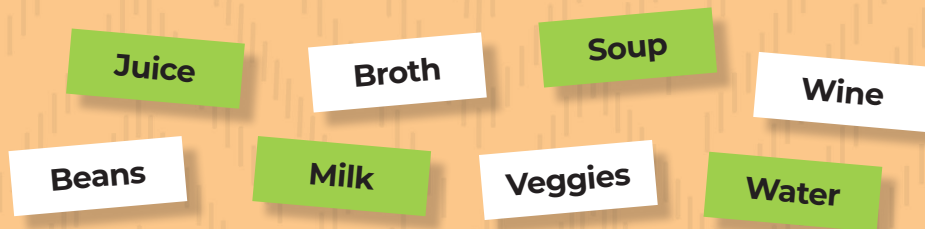


What happens to a carton
